

GUIDELINES FOR FALL CLEAN UP WEEK

SEPT. 29th – OCT 4th, 2008

REMEMBER

CITY WIDE CLEAN UP DAYS ARE A BENEFIT TO CITIZENS, NOT A MANDATORY SERVICE. PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF OUR WORKERS AND DO NOT ABUSE CLEAN UP DAYS.

- No demolition materials - at curbside or at dumpsters. This includes: cement, lumber, siding, sheetrock, fencing. Demolition materials should be taken to Marion County Transfer Station @ 320 W. Santa Fe, Marion, KS. Please call them in advance at 620/382-5655.
- No yard waste (i.e. leaves, limbs or grass) at dumpsters or curbside. Take yard waste to our burn pit.

MANNED ROLL OFF DUMPSTER @ FIRST AND OLIVE STREETS

- Marion County Commissioners determined that each city in the county may have one (1) week for cleanup in both the spring and fall. Therefore our expanded scheduled dumpster days are:

29 September Monday 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

1 October Wednesday 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

4 October Saturday 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

- These dumpsters will be manned by Stutzman Refuse and are for residential customers inside the city limits of Peabody, Kansas. Be prepared to show proof of residence by driver's license or water bill stub.
- Tires will be accepted at \$4 each.
- Please note that the dumpster will only be available for ½ day on Saturday, October 4th from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., since Marion County Transfer Station closes at noon on Saturdays.

CURBSIDE PICK UP- FRIDAY October 3, 2008

- Curbside pick up was initially designed for residential customers: senior citizens, one-person households, and citizens who do not have access to an appropriate vehicle to haul refuse to the dumpsters. (Not for commercial facilities.)
- You may begin placing items at curbside as of Sunday, September 28th. Placing items on the curb earlier than this gives our town a "trashy" appearance for too long a period, and is an invitation for scavengers, stray animals, and poor weather conditions to strew trash all over your neighborhood.
 - Remember the 3 Bs – **BAG, BOX OR BUNDLE**. Items taken to the curb should not be thrown loose in a heaping mound, expecting refuse collectors to pick and sort through the refuse piece by piece OR use a shovel. PLEASE secure and compact your items into boxes, bags or such, to make collection safer, cleaner and faster. If refuse doesn't match the 3 Bs – it will not be picked up.
 - Metal items should be placed at the curb separately. A different truck and crew collects these items. Appliances (white goods) should be set to the side – clearly accessible without wading through other trash piles.
 - Call the city office on appliances – specifically appliances that use refrigerant – as these need to be specially tagged for disposal.
 - All refrigerators and freezers should have their doors removed (\$20 each with advance tags).
