VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION



Kansas Voter Registration Applications are available at the City Office (for U.S. Citizens only). The form is also available at <u>www.kssos.org</u>. This application is used to:

- Register to vote in Kansas
- Change you name or your address on your registration
- Affiliate with a political party or change your party affiliation

To register to vote you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be a resident of the State of Kansas
- Have reached the age of eighteen (18) years before the next statewide general election
- Have received final discharge from imprisonment, parole, or conditional release if convicted of a felony
- Have abandoned your former residence and/or name

Important:

- Return your completed application to your county (Marion County, Courthouse PO Box 219, Marion, KS 66861)
- Your County Election Officer will mail you a notice when your application has been processed.
- This application must be postmarked by the 15th day before an election in order to be eligible to be registered in that election.
- The last four digits of your Social Security number will be used for administrative purposes only and will not be disclosed to the public (KSA 25-2309).
- If you decline to register to vote, that fact will remain confidential and will be used for voter registration purposed only. If you do register to vote, the office where you apply will be confidential and will be used for voter registration purposes only.
